Driver's Information

Welcome to Ben Hur Speedway! We ask that you take a minute to familiarize yourself with the following information.

1. All karts must be equipped with a transponder. Transponders must be carried in pocket.
2. Report to pump around with a full tank. No Exceptions!! You must report to pump around with your class for qualifying, heat and features. Karts must be on ground at pump around in pre-grid.
3. All drivers will be held responsible for their actions and those of their crew. Foul language, unruliness or threatening of race officials or other drivers will not be tolerated.
4. It is your responsibility to return transponders to race officials. Failure to do so will result in a \$250 replacement fee.

Qualifying & Race Procedures

1. Group qualifying format will be used. Each group will qualify 3 timed laps. This will determine your starting position for the heat races with up to the top 6 qualifiers possibly being inverted. Your finishing position of the heat races will be the line up for the features.
2. There will be no waiting on the grid. Classes need to be in the grid lined up before the finish of previous race or you will start at the tail of your heat.
3. Burris slick tires only, except Rookies. Tires must be on kart through pump around. Tire warmers, covers, etc. must be removed before pump around.
4. Race starts will be on front straight away by flagman. There will be 2 tries, double file with all competitors making one lap under green. If not able to start on 2nd try, we will go single file – original line up. (If officials feel that someone spun alone, track will stay green – no restart.) On single file start, track will stay green unless track is blocked or a competitor is at risk or injured.
5. Heats will consist of 10 laps and Features will consist of 15 laps.
6. We do not race back to a red flag or a caution flag. We will revert back to the previous lap with all karts involved placed to the rear (no exceptions).
7. Rough driving, blocking, and punting a fellow competitor will not be tolerated and will be dealt with quickly.
8. Maximum Field for any Race is 30 Karts; Minimum Field for any Race is 5 Karts pre-registered.

Trophies awarded second night. In order for a class to qualify for trophies, it must race both nights.

One trophy awarded for each three entries - maximum five places.
